Receiving Toys

May - June 2020

Close to 1,000 toys were shipped directly to LV Middle School in New Jersey. Two 18-wheeler trucks in total delivered 48 pallets of toys to Kansas and California. Each location, in accordance with their safety protocols, received and stored the toys until it was safe to distribute them to families in need.

Over the span of 6 months, students from all over the country sent hundreds of notes of friendship to accompany the toys. This special activity allowed students to think about - and connect with - the receiving children through the process of writing messages of love and support.

With students feeling isolated during the pandemic, The Great Toy Giveaway gave them a unique opportunity to feel connected and part of something bigger than themselves.

We were thrilled that hundreds of students - through both virtual and in-person learning - participated in The Great Toy Giveaway by writing their messages of love and support. These heartfelt notes definitely added an extra infusion of love to every toy!















GTG Distribution Events

Bringing Joy During The Holiday Season

Our team was determined to host the 3 Great Toy Giveaway events during the 2020 winter holidays. With so many families being financially impacted by COVID-19, we knew that the gift of new toys couldn't come at a more perfect time. One of the California event recipients shared:

The 3 Great Toy Giveaway events in California, Kansas and New Jersey all took place on Giving Tuesday, December 3rd, 2020. We loved the synergy and the media appeal of aligning our Great Toy Giveaway events with this global day of giving. Each event was hosted in accordance with local health and safety guidelines and protocols. We hosted a drive-through toy distribution event in California, an outdoor community event in New Jersey and an indoor event in Kansas.



GTG Carlsbad, CA Event

With strict COVID-19 restrictions in place in Carlsbad, CA, we organized an invitation only drive-through event. Sixty-six families from a local title-1 school (a federally recognized low income school), a local Boys and Girls Club and other vulnerable families received toys during the drive-through Great Toy Giveaway event.

The timing of the Carlsbad event was particularly important due to the cancellation of the local Carlsbad Christmas Bureau, a program which for the past 50 years has provided hundreds of local low-income families with Christmas gifts. We are grateful to have been able to fill that community need thanks to the generosity of The Toy Foundation.

Despite the face masks, smiles and holiday cheer were abundant!















GTG Roselle, NJ Event

The Leonard V. Moore Middle School Generation On Kids Care Club in partnership with the Roselle Police Department, hosted a community-wide Great Toy Giveaway event. On a first-come, first-served basis, the event attracted families from Roselle Public Schools including Harrison Elementary, Polk Elementary, Washington Elementary and Kindergarten Success Academy.

Over 1,000 toys, all thoughtfully displayed on tables set up in the Leonard V. Moore Middle School parking lot, were joyfully distributed to children and families. We are so happy to know that children of Roselle felt loved and cared for through the gift of new toys.















GTG Kansas City, KS Event

Our friends in Kansas made us proud! They hosted an amazing holiday Great Toy Giveaway event in partnership with Sporting KC, their professional soccer team. The Children's Mercy Park Stadium in Kansas City, Kansas was a perfect venue to share hot cocoa, Santa Claus and hundreds of toys with 66 vulnerable families and over 200 grateful children!

In the spirit of giving, hundreds of toys were also safely delivered to the following community organizations: Children's Mercy Hospital, Shadow Buddies, KVC Health Systems, Shawnee Community Services, the Shawnee Police & Fire Departments, Sunrise Senior Living, Phoenix Family, The Jared Box Project and Benninghoven Elementary. These organizations ensured the toys were delivered to additional kids in need, extending the reach of The Great Toy Giveaway.
